

2024 SPAA Bullseye 22 Pistol League Schedule

The Laidback League

- Dates:** Spring 900 League Every Wednesday night, 17 Apr thru 12 June
Fall 900 League Every Wednesday night, 07 Aug thru 02 Oct
- *Awards will be based on the best 5 matches for each league.
- Time:** 900 League – **ONE** relay – Gate will open at 1730 (530pm), Relay starts at 1745,
Limited to 35 participants
- Location:** Seattle Police Athletic Association
11030 E. Marginal Way S.
Tukwila, WA 98168
- Directions:** Take exit 158 from I-5 (Airport Way/ E. Marginal Way). Drive West to the traffic light at Highway 99 (stay in left lane - East Marginal Way only). Turn hard left at the light and go South on East Marginal Way South. Range entrance is 500 yards from the light on the left. Take a left inside the gate to get to the pistol range (covered, gray structure).
- Eligibility:** All competitors must be 16 years of age or older.
- Entry Fees:** Match Fees 900 League \$ 40.00 per League Session
- Payable at the time of registration. Doors will open early to allow for registration.
- Rules:** Be safe, have fun. Muzzles may not point above the backstop at any time. Fingers must be outside the trigger guard unless you are firing or dry firing and the gun is pointed towards the targets. All NRA rules apply. **The wearing of eye and ear protection is Mandatory.** The leagues are NRA Approved.
- Squadding:** Range capacity limits entries to 35. Shooters will be assigned firing points on a first come first serve basis. Competitors must be in attendance 15 minutes prior to the relay start time to hold reserved firing positions.
- Classifications:** Master, Expert, Sharpshooter, Marksman. Non-classified competitors will be classified based on their scores throughout the league.
- Course of Fire** 900 league - **22 caliber only**, all targets at 25 yds (slow fire on 25 yd reduced targets).
- Scoring:** Target changing and scoring will be done by the competitors.
- Awards:** Individual cash awards for Aggregate Match Winner, weekly High Individual, and 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each class. Scoring for Awards will be based on the best 5 targets posted for the league session – this means you have plenty of time to turn in enough targets to get on the board,
